EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

Dear Parents of Students:

In compliance with Emergency Plans and Safety Programs (OAR 581-22-706), Sherwood School District has been making preparations in the event a major earthquake or other disaster should occur. Plans in place include:

- A written emergency plan for each building.
- Emergency containers placed at each location. Stored in these containers will be basic essential supplies to last a period of 72 hours. The District will supply some items, including first aid supplies, lanterns, paper supplies, and radio equipment. Also stored for each student are supplies consisting of food bars, water, and space blankets. The food supplies have a shelf life of six years.

A one-time \$10 fee for each student is necessary to cover the cost of these supplies. This fee was approved by the Board of Education in August 1997.
